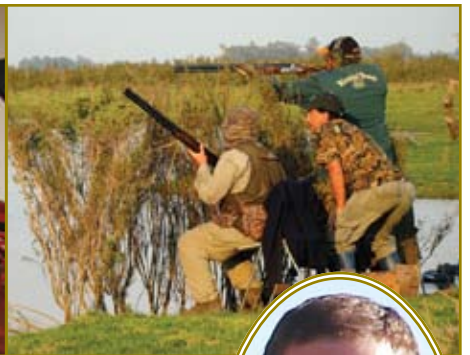

This first rate hunting lodge is just a short 2 hour drive from Buenos Aires and is situated on about 200,000 acres of owned and leased hunting property with excellent and dependable duck water from the Uruguay River. Excellent accommodations, food, service and amenities at very reasonable rates.



This area offers hunters an abundance of ducks, pigeons, perdiz and doves with liberal daily limits plus an option for Red Stag. Patricio Geijo of Argentina Bird Hunting understands what it takes to deliver a truly first rate hunting experience.

As for shooting expectations, all the species are abundant and the reasonable limits are a little flexible. Our commitment is provide a excellent hunt, and unforgettable outdoors experiences yet preserve our natural resources.

Expectations for early morning ducks should be 4-5 boxes per hunter. Pigeons hunts are 5-6 boxes per hunt per shooter and perdiz hunts expectations are about 10-12 birds per day.

The Duck hunts are well organized. The blinds are dry or wooden floors if hunters need to stay in the water, with a minimum number of decoys, roboducks, wind ducks. The guides and bird boys handle the gear and dogs and all the little details like hot chocolate, warm soup or coffee in the blind.

Hunter's requests are welcomed. This is a first class and very comfortable lodge with very good service, food and wine. The chef and kitchen staff take care of all the little details which make a big difference in fine dining. Expect fresh orange juice with or without pulp, crispy bacon, eggs prepared "anyway you like", American sauces and dressings for salads, savory field Asados and delicious dinner menus accompanied by premium wines.
